

RA Centre Life Membership Award

Definition

The RA Life Membership Award recognizes Regular and Pioneer Members who, over a significant period of time, have demonstrated meritorious service in the promotion of recreational activities on behalf of the Association and for outstanding contributions to the development of the Association.

Criteria

The nominee must be a member of the Recreation Association and have been a member for a minimum of ten consecutive years.

The nominee must show evidence of strong identifiable contributions to the promotion, development, management or organization of the Association and its activity(ies).

The nominee may also have been recognized for outstanding contributions to the community on behalf of the Association.

Contribution to the Association would include, but not be limited to, the activities of Association volunteers such as departmental representatives, members of the Board of Trustees and Board of Directors, non-specified event organizers and volunteer officials.

Contribution to an activity would include, but not be limited to, volunteer service as a member of a club executive, volunteer service on behalf of a club, class or league, volunteer officials, organizers or convenors.

Each nomination must be accompanied by the signatures of a minimum of four members of the Association.

Nomination and Selection

The Recognition and Awards Committee will solicit nominations every two years.

The Recognition and Awards Committee will review all submissions.

The Association will award a maximum of two Life Memberships every two years.
